RE: Sidewalks and Trails Map

### **ACTION REQUESTED**

### **BACKGROUND**

At the January Parks & Recreation Commission Meeting, staff provided the Commission with the current sidewalk and trails map and asked the Commission to review the map and provide any input on any potential gaps within the Little Canada trail and sidewalk system.

Creating an updated pedestrian trail and sidewalk map is a first-year action of the City's 2022 Strategic Plan under the strategic direction - *Maximizing our Assets to Catalyze Development*.

Staff will have a large map at the meeting if Commissioners would like to add any comments identifying any potential gaps. Commissioners can also send any comments they have to the Parks & Recreation Director.

Once comments have been received by the Commissions and staff, the map will be updated and brought forward to the City Council for adoption in March 2023. The intent of updating the sidewalk and trails map is for the document to serve as a guide for future planning, development, and funding allocations. The updated map could also be used when procuring potential grant funds that may be available.

### **STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends the Commission bring forward any recommended changes to the February Parks & Recreation Commission meeting.
