



Construction Newsletter

August 23, 2018

Although most residents are likely aware the Contractor moved the mailbox bank onto Little Canada Road just east of Park View Court. We were not notified of this move in advance and apologize that no advanced notice was provided to residents. We have received some concerns from residents regarding picking up mail on LC Road due to the higher traffic volume. The Contractor was given the Postmasters contact number to coordinate relocation of the mailbox. At this time we do not know if this was the location directed by the Postmaster or not, however we are contacting the Postmaster to see if the temporary location could be moved onto Jackson Street. Once that option has been explored the mailbox may be moved to Jackson Street. If it is approved to move the mailbox from its current temporary location residents will be notified by newsletter of the move.

The mailbox is higher than it was in its original position because the Contractor moved the mailbox and entire pad, setting it on the LC Road boulevard. The mail carrier has been able to deliver to the box, but we want to make sure all residents can access their mail at the higher temporary height. We would ask that each resident attempt to get their mail with the mailbox at its current height. If you are unable to get your mail due to the height of the box please email or call the City Engineer and we will have the contractor lower the mailbox. The contact information for the City Engineer is listed at the bottom of this newsletter.

Schedule

The Contractor has indicated that he will be providing an updated schedule for the remaining work by the end of the day, and we will provide that information with another construction newsletter. We do not believe any additional work will be occurring on Parkview Court until next week at the earliest.
